"This stand expresses the prevalent attitude among today's university youth", stated CUS president Jean Bazin in his letter to committee members.

"The Canadian Union of Students is deeply concerned with the state of affairs in the House of Commons, regarding a Canadian flag", he said. "We expect that a recommendation will finally be forthcoming and that, in the interests of Canadian unity and progress, this recommendation will be accepted by the House of Commons after but a short subsequent debate.

One member of the Special Committe replied to Mr. Bazin that "the choice of a flag is a very important matter to the entire country, and I am more than
