Helen Kelly

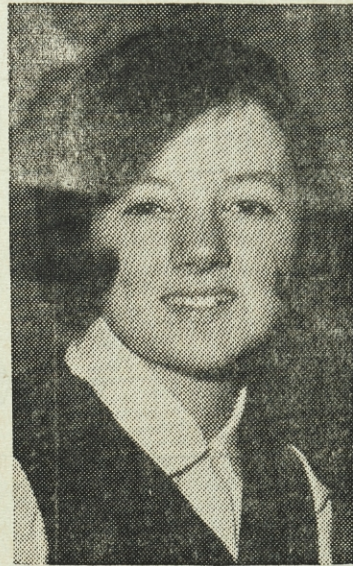
