If we are to overcome the present-day materialistic society and replace it with a Christian society we must be prepared to suffer in the struggle. Since Our Lady's appearance at Fatima and Lourdes to beg for our conversion we have no choice but to accept suffering. It is by such methods that a spiritual revolution must take place that we may, as Peter Maurin said, create a new society within the shell of the old, with a philosophy so old that it looks like new.
