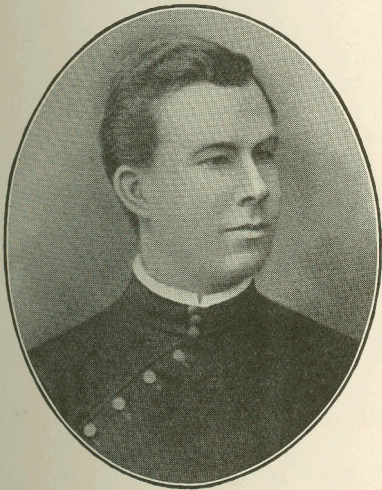


In Memoriam

Reverend Ronald Joseph Gillis.

On December 12th, 1912, Reverend Ronald Joseph Gillis, Pastor of Saint Peter's Bay, P. E. I., passed away in the fifty-fifth year of his life and the twenty-sixth of his priesthood. The deceased priest was educated at Saint Dunstan's College, Charlottetown, and the Propaganda, Rome. All his endeavors were directed towards the spiritual and temporal uplift of his people and the erection and ornamentation of the parish church at Saint Peter's, which is one of the finest of Lower Province churches, a fitting monument to his endeavors. His remain rest in the vault of the church, beside those of his former pastor, Right Reverend Peter MacIntyre, third Bishop of Charlottetown.

During the twenty-six years of his pastorate at Saint Peters, Father Gillis ingratiated himself into the hearts of young and old who alike mourn the untimely demise of a faithful friend and beloved priest called away in the zenith of his usefulness. Requiescat in Pace!
