



MONSIGNOR J. A. SULLIVAN  
RECTOR AND PRESIDENT OF ST. DUNSTAN'S UNIVERSITY

Monsignor J. A. Sullivan, Rector and President of St. Dunstan's was formally invested as a Domestic Prelate by His Excellency, Most Reverend Malcolm A. MacEachern D.D., Bishop of Charlottetown on Sunday evening, September 28, 1958.

The impressive investiture ceremony was conducted in the university chapel before a large congregation, which included the faculty and student body. His Excellency was assisted in the ceremony by Rev. E. J. Roche and Rev. F. P. Aylward. The official ceremony began with the reading of the Papal announcement by Rev. R. G. Ellsworth, this was followed by the blessing of the robes and vestments and formal vesting by Bishop MacEachern. Monsignor Sullivan was appointed Vice-rector of St. Dunstan's in 1943 and succeeded Monsignor R. V. MacKenzie as Rector in 1956.
